Gifts from Wills and Trusts:

When making a charitable gift to a nonprofit organization, it is vital that the charity's legal name, address, and other identifying details be used. To name Illinois Institute of Technology in your will or trust, please use the following suggested language:

To the University, unrestricted:

"I give to Illinois Institute of Technology, an Illinois corporation, Chicago, Illinois, (the sum of \$_____) or (_____ percent of the remainder of my estate) to be used for the benefit of said University in such manner as the trustees thereof may direct."

To a particular school, unrestricted:

"I give to Illinois Institute of Technology, an Illinois Corporation, Chicago, Illinois, (the sum of \$_____) or (_____ percent of the remainder of my estate) to be used for the benefit of the (school of your choice) for its unrestricted purposes."

To a particular school for a particular purpose:

"I give to Illinois Institute of Technology, an Illinois Corporation, Chicago, Illinois, (the sum of \$_____) or (_____ percent of the remainder of my estate) to be used by (school of your choice) for support of _____."
